Guidelines -

- You are responsible to bring your own water, tent, table and chairs. Space is assigned based on a 10x10 tent. Location will be determined after the application is received.
- Your booth should be staffed during the entire Festival 10 am until 4 pm
- Set up Some crafters ask to set up their booth on Friday, August 18. Details for times available will be sent out with confirmation but Friday is an option. However, all participants are reminded there is no security for items left outside of the building overnight.
- Set up on Saturday will be between 7 am and 9 am.
- If you plan to sell or give away food, this request needs to be approved by the Festival committee. Please make this request on your application.
- Any plan to raffle an item has to be approved. Again, make this request on your application and give details.
- No selling, solicitation or giving away of materials should be offered outside the booth space.
- The inside of the Cowee School is used for some events and the entire outside campus is utilized. The Festival will be held rain or shine and no refunds will be given due to weather.
- We ask that participants not begin taking down your station before 4 pm. For safety, we will not allow any vehicles onto the campus until 4 pm. We will arrange shuttles to take you to your vehicles.
- There will be trash cans available around the field, but we ask you to carry off any trash you have generated at your booth during the day.

Funding for this type of festival is minimal and we ask for your support by considering giving a donation to the Festival.
